



Secondary Uniform

Wearing a school uniform is a badge of pride, it creates our identity and is an important part of being a member of our school community. Wearing it says 'we're all in this together.'

I am striving to see a more consistent and formal approach to our uniform standards and wish for every child to wear the correct uniform with great pride each day.

Pupils not wearing the correct school uniform or PE kit in the short-term should have a letter from their parent explaining the situation and an expected date when it will all be present.

If no letter is present, the following sanctions will be in place:

- 1st occasion – 15-minute lunch time detention and note in their diary
- 2nd occasion – 30-minute detention and teacher will make direct contact with the parent
- 3rd occasion – 60-minute detention, parent contacted and pupil will not be able to join lessons until the uniform is present.
- 4th occasion – fixed-term exclusion

Secondary pupils:

Boys

- Black trousers, white shirt, black and gold tie, black Auckland College jumper, Grey blazer with Auckland College badge, black socks and flat black formal leather shoes.

Girls

- Blue and yellow kilt, white shirt, black and gold tie, black Auckland College jumper, grey blazer with Auckland College badge, black socks/tights and flat black formal leather shoes.

Coat

- Plain black waterproof coat

PE Kit:

- White Auckland College polo shirt
- Black Auckland College sweatshirt
- Plain black jogging bottoms or shorts (not leggings)
- Black/white socks
- White trainers
