They will also begin to understand more advance GCSE topics and how different fitness components can be applied to different sports.</p>	<p>The purpose of this unit of work is for learners to compete at high levels of performance. Learners can compete in a variety of events, based on running, jumping and throwing and get to compete against each other competitively. They should be able to understand how to effectively assess each other to look to improve efforts in different athletic events.</p>	<p>The purpose of this unit of work is to develop specific skills in striking and fielding such as catching, throwing and striking the ball. Pupils will also learn advanced ways to bowl, strike the ball and fielding techniques.</p>
