<p><b>AO: To examine what life was like in England during the Anglo-Saxon era</b></p> <p>Pupils will explore why England was so attractive to foreign invaders during the Anglo-Saxon era and will then investigate the succession crisis of 1066.</p> <p>Topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What Britain was like before 1066?</li> <li>• Death of Edward the Confessor</li> <li>• The claimants to the throne of England</li> <li>• The Battle of Stamford Bridge</li> <li>• The Battle of Hastings</li> <li>• The Bayeux Tapestry</li> </ul>	<p><b>AO: To explore how William ruled England and enforced his power</b></p> <p>Pupils will explore how William the Conqueror controlled the English population and introduced different changes to English society in order to do this.</p> <p>Topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Domesday Book</li> <li>• The Feudal System</li> <li>• The Harrying of the North</li> <li>• Castles and their defence and attack</li> </ul>	<p><b>AO: To examine the Tudor monarchs and the changes they had on society, especially religion</b></p> <p>Pupils will explore each Tudor monarch from Henry VII to Elizabeth I and how they contributed to the religious rollercoaster that followed the English Reformation.
