They will compare settlements from different locations around the world and their local area and then identify the patterns they can find in these settlements.</p> <p>Topics include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Settlement functions • Site, situation and settlement patterns • Why settlements change • Changes in retail • Brazil • Brownfield vs Greenfield sites <p>Main text: Progress in Geography, Key Stage 3, HODDER EDUCATION</p>	<p>AO: To describe and explain the causes and consequences of Natural Hazards</p> <p>Pupils will examine the processes associated with the physical environment and some of the most prominent challenges that we face globally. Pupils will develop their abilities to analyse and predict future events, as well as manage and mitigate their effects to support communities when they need it most.</p> <p>Topics include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plate tectonics • Earthquakes • Volcanoes • Tsunamis • Hurricanes • Comparing MEDC and LEDC disasters 	<p>AO: To consolidate our knowledge from this academic year</p> <p>Pupils will use different revision techniques to consolidate their knowledge from the year.
